PLEA FROM A NIGERIAN PRINCESS

100,000 Meals for Victims of Terrorism.

When Princess Modupe Ozolua of Nigeria emailed our CEO this Fall, pleading for healthy meals for survivors of terrorism, the reply was obvious! A member of the royal Benin kingdom family, Princess Ozolua Modupe's great-grandfather was a legendary warrior-king. Decades later, she's fighting for the vulnerable in remarkable ways. FCE provided 100,000 meals for internally displaced people in northeast Nigeria who've suffered unimaginably at the hands of the terrorist group Boko Haram.



UNITED WE STAND AGAINST HUNGER

Hunger Heroes Package 505,728 Healthy Meals on 9/11.

The goal was to transform 9/11 from a day of despair into a day of love and service. To accomplish this, more than 2,000 New Yorkers came together with U.S. Hunger and packaged 505,728 meals for families, seniors and veterans at risk of hunger. Later that day, just a few blocks from ground zero, parishioners at Trinity Church Wall Street and St. Paul's Chapel served the very meal they had packaged to a long line of hungry people.



TEACHER OF THE YEAR ENRICHES LIVES OUTSIDE THE CLASSROOM

Louisiana Flooding Survivors Receive 25,000 Meals.

When Lockhart's teacher of the year, Dr. Cheryl Johnson, learned of the flooding, she started a clothing drive with employees at the school. However, she knew there was more that could be done. Like many schools throughout the country, Lockhart Middle School in Orlando has a food pantry for students and their families in need, which included healthy meals from FCE. Having seen first hand how these meals were well-received by local families, Dr. Cheryl Johnson contacted FCE about sending meals to Louisiana. The result of her efforts? The 25,000 meals packaged by volunteers during FCE's sixth birthday celebration were loaded onto a truck and driven to Louisiana and distributed just two miles from ground zero of the flooding.
