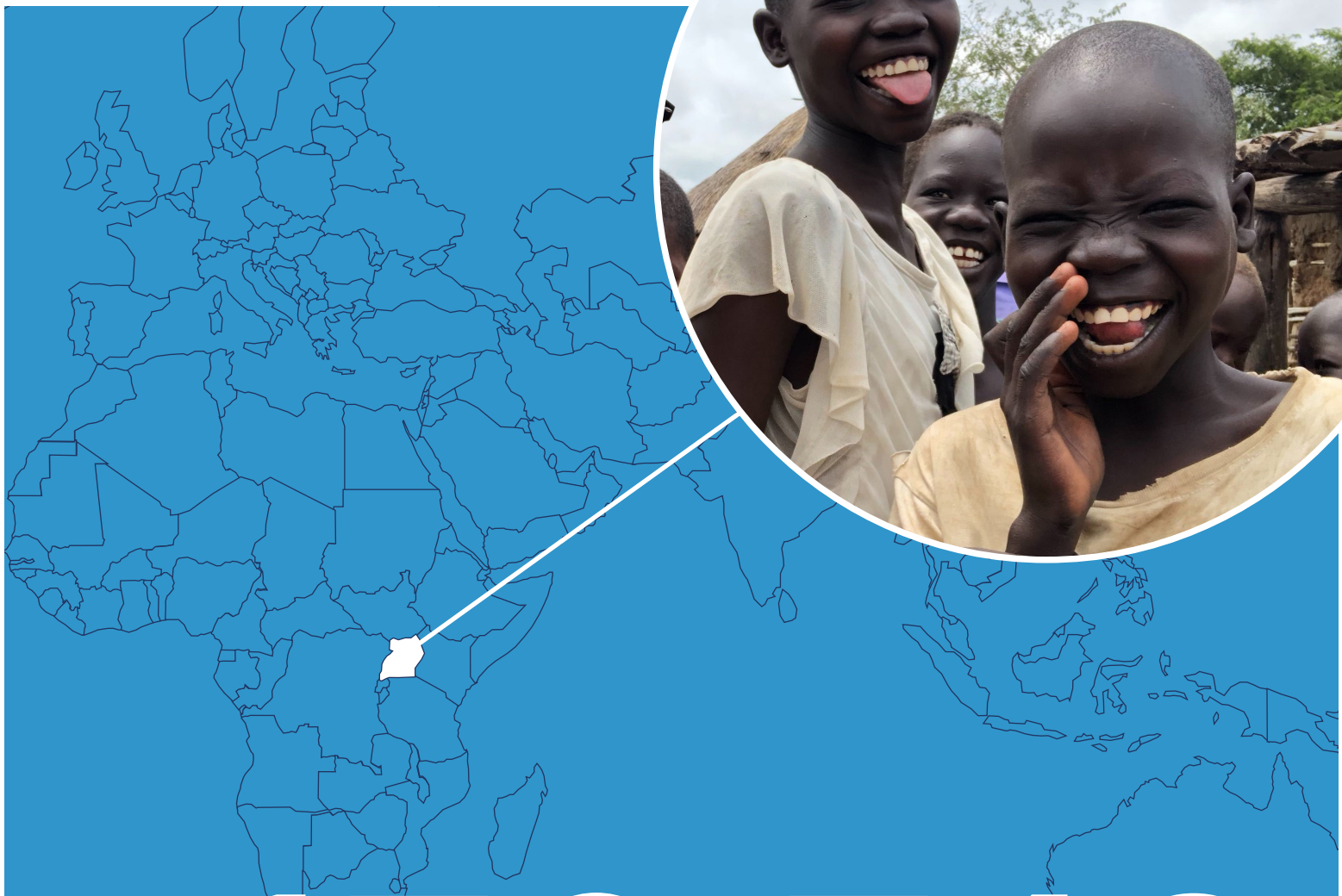

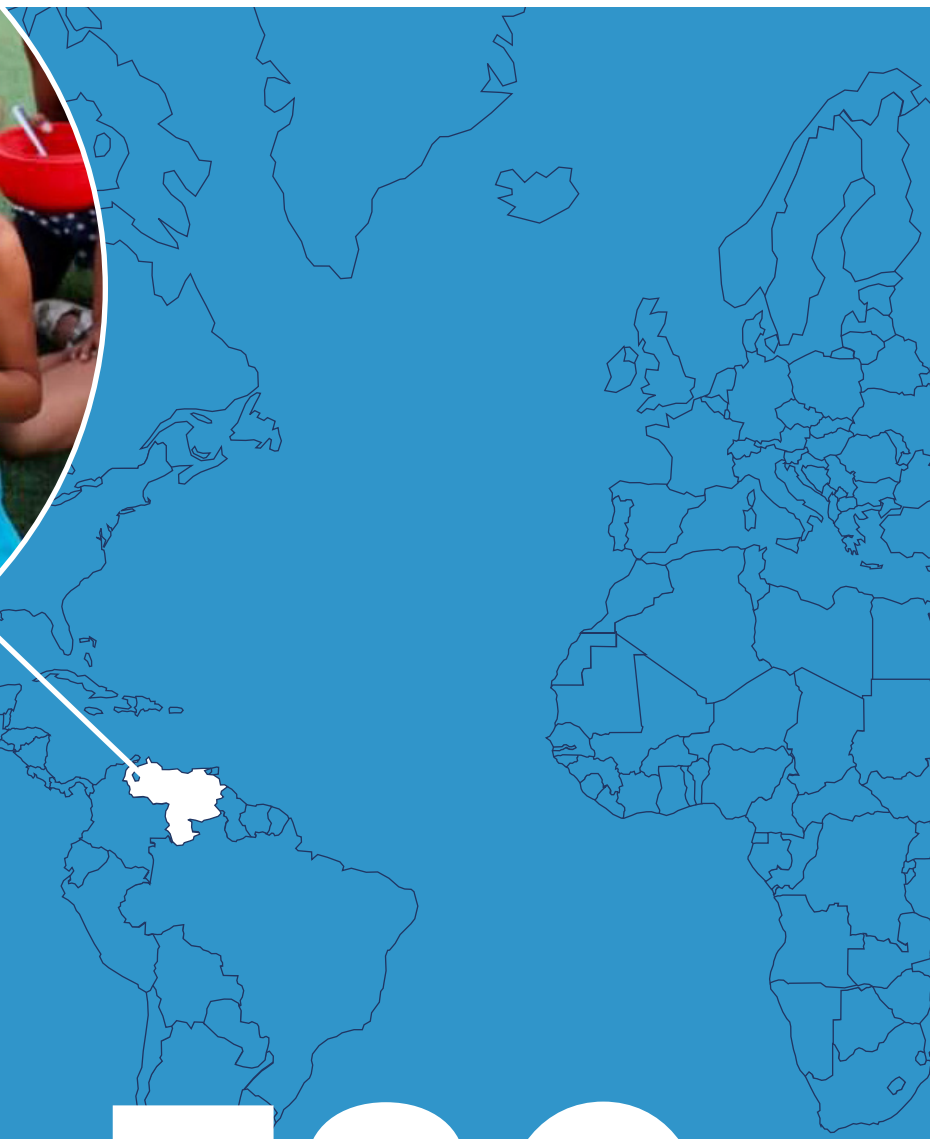

South Sudanese Refugees

With increasing violence and deteriorating conditions, the crisis in South Sudan has escalated to a full-blown humanitarian emergency. The South

Sudanese makeup 1.4 million of the world's refugees and many flee to settlements like Northern Uganda. Over the last 8 years, South Sudan has been ravaged by civil conflict and famine. In a country where hope is hard to find, you helped send over 170,000 meals to refugees.

Meals to Venezuelan Community

Venezuela has struggled with a country-wide crisis for many years. The economic and political issues have taken a huge toll on the people, making food supply scarce for a majority of the country. A hometown Hunger Hero partnered with FCE to do whatever it took to help save the lives of children in Venezuela. Because of this effort in addition to other local organizations, over 129,000 meals were delivered to the hardest hit areas.

Meals for Children in Haiti

Between the difficult terrain, lack of agricultural programs and vulnerability to natural disasters, the people of Haiti have little to no access to necessary nutrition. Working alongside our very first partner, Open Door Haiti, and another ministry focused on children, our Hunger Heroes helped provide over 292,000 meals.

Meals Hurricane Relief in the Bahamas

After Hurricane Dorian, damage to homes and places of employment caused many families in the Bahamas to be out of work for weeks without pay. Meanwhile, loss of power and damaged streets inhibit transportation to access food and water. Many households already struggled to put food on the table and searched for a place to turn for help. Because of you, over 500,000 meals were distributed on the ground to provide relief in the Bahamas.

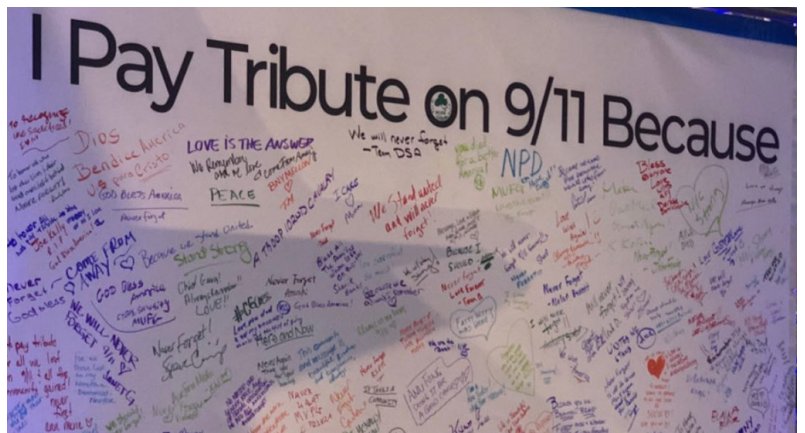

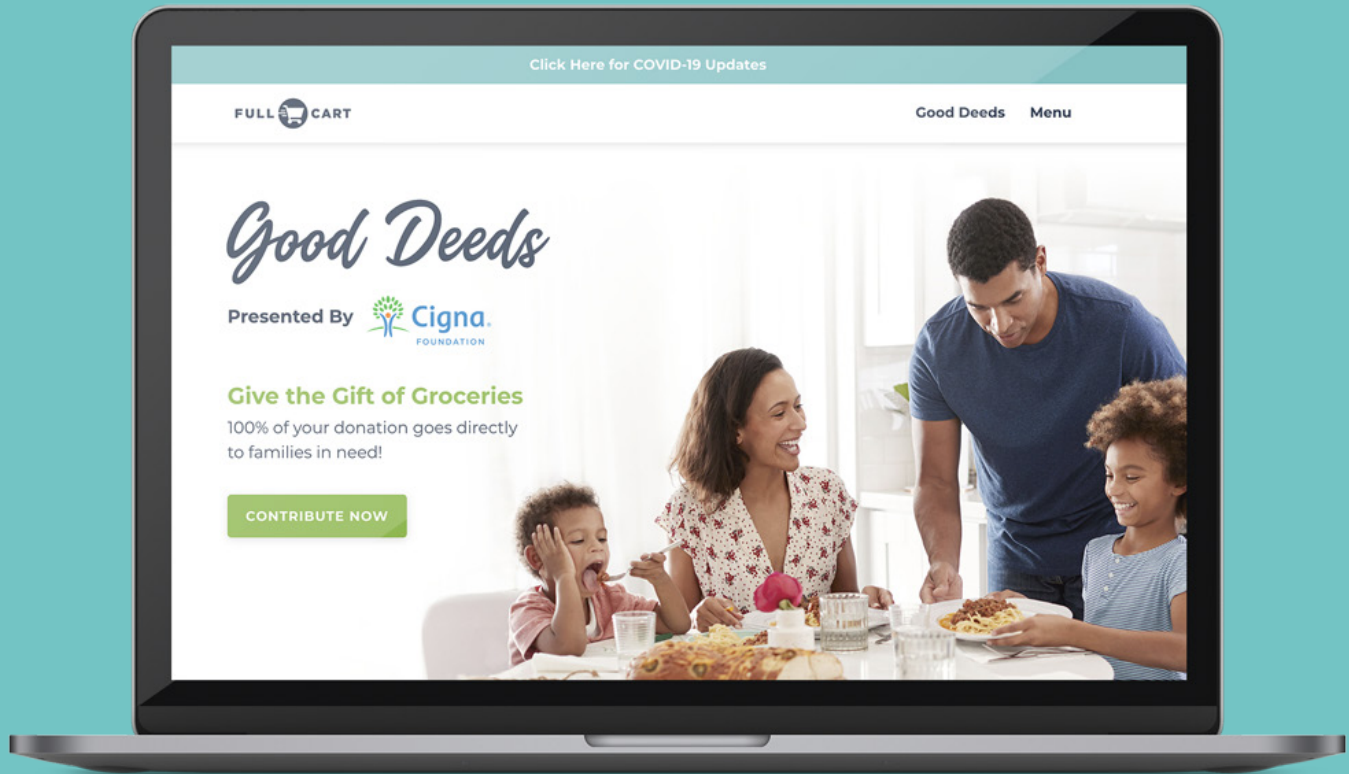

GOVERNMENT SHUTDOWN

January 2019 - The activation of the Full Cart program helped combat the effects of the government shut down. Teaming up with funders including Robin Hood Foundation, AARP Foundation, Silicon Valley Community Foundation, Omidyar Network, and NY-based startup Propel, FCE delivered 12,000 Full Cart food boxes to the doorsteps of families of furloughed federal employees, contractors with missed paychecks, and many more that were left without supplemental food assistance.

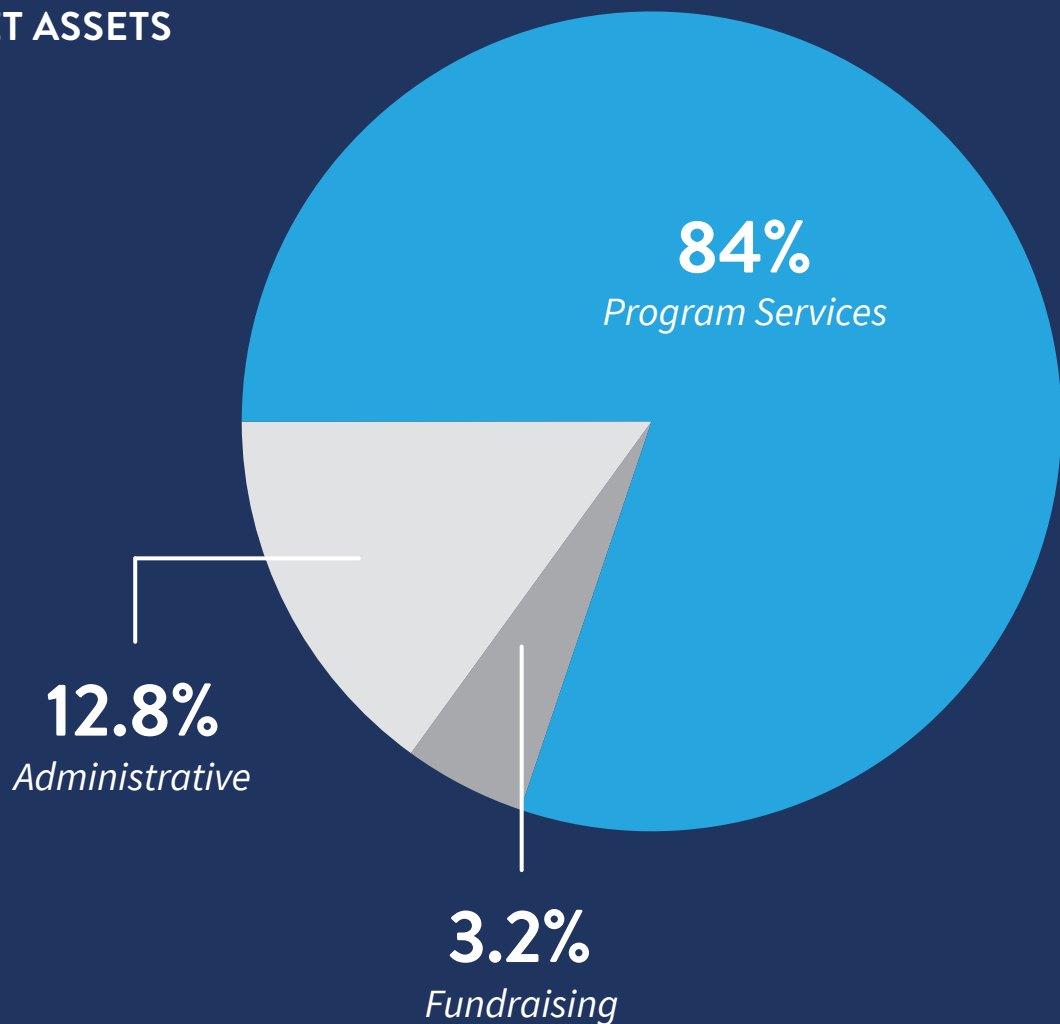
